On June 13, 2017 the Street Crimes Unit along with Officers from Probation/Parole conducted a search of the Teresa Lambert's residence in Keiser. During the search Officers found several items of drug paraphernalia including syringes, corner baggies containing methamphetamine residue and a spoon containing methamphetamine residue. Officers also located a locked safe. Mrs. Lambert stated she didn't remember the combination to the safe. Mrs. Lambert was transported to the Mississippi County Sheriff Department and she was charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (misdemeanor).

On June 14, 2017 Officers with the Street Crimes Unit obtained a search warrant to enter the safe. The Osceola Fire Department assisted in opening the safe. Officers found more drug paraphernalia inside the safe including syringes, digital scales, baggies containing methamphetamine residue and two glass pipes used for smoking methamphetamine.

Mrs. Lambert appeared in Osceola District Court and pled guilty to Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and received a \$200 fine plus court cost and 30 days in jail suspended.
